Organisations, whether profit driven, non-profit or a charity, exist to deliver product(s) and / or service(s). Every product or service may require special objectives and goals, which may differ from time to time, depending on a complex set of circumstances. Time, cost and quality are the so-called '*golden triangle*' of product and service objective categories. In general, as organisations seek to reduce time spent and increase quality they are actually trying to improve the level of service provided; as organisations seek to reduce costs and increase quality they are actually trying to improve the level of value provided. Often safety and the environment are simply considered 'add-ons' or are ineffectively buried under quality; as organisations struggle to fit these objective categories into the '*golden triangle*'.

As organisations mature and evolve towards integrated quality, safety and environmental management systems, the most common critical objectives, irrespective of the type of product or service being delivered, are often:

- To complete the product or service in the shortest possible time;
- To complete the product or service at the lowest possible cost;
- To achieve the best quality of workmanship on the product or service;
- To execute the product or service with the highest possible safety record; and
- To execute the product or service with the minimal impact on the environment

Many organisations find it impossible to balance all five of these objectives because they find them conflicting:

- To complete the product or service in the shortest time may see costs increase while quality, safety and the environment may be impacted;
- To complete the product or service at the lowest cost may see time increase while quality, safety and the environment may be impacted;
- To achieve the best quality may result in both time and cost increases;
- To achieve the highest safety may see time and costs increase while the environment may be impacted; and
- To achieve minimal environmental impact may see time and costs increase while safety may be impacted.
